Inspired by the Japanese Ofuro, the SOAK is a two person, outdoor wood-fired soaking tub with a propane heating option. Designed to create an intimate and restorative experience, perfect for backyard adventures to remote cabin locations.

QUALITY MATERIALS, MADE TO LAST

Marine grade aluminum, stainless steel, Red Cedar, Powder Coating, High quality UV outdoor fabric

WEIGHT

290 lbs. moveable with two people with
woodwork & stove pipe removed

DIMENSIONS

L: 90" x W: 32" x H: 34"

CAPACITY

570 L / 150 G water / 1,256 lbs. filled

USE

1. Fill with water, keep covered.
2. Chop wood, make fire.
3. Stir occasionally, maintain fire.
4. Back off the fire when close to temp.
5. Ready for use at 100-104 °F.
6. When water is cool, release through lower tap.

7. Water can be used for several days.
Safe for use with Epsom Salts, baking soda, food grade hydrogen peroxide, etc.

Depending on region and starting water temp, the heat-up takes an approx. 3 hrs.

DESIGN INNOVATION

The side accessed stove box allows for the use of a propane burner.

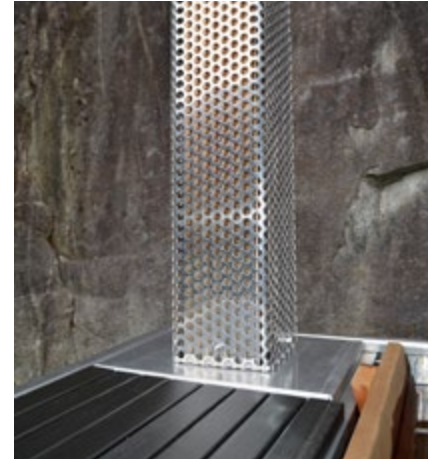
